Miriam Medical Clinics has been in operation since 2013. Over the past eight years we have provided care for hundreds of people. In addition, we have provided over 15,000 COVID vaccinations, including booster shots.

Our patients come from a variety of backgrounds and economic challenges. Some of them have adequate financial and insurance resources. However, many of them have been released from incarceration, half-way houses, recovery and rehabilitation facilities, and other long-term care facilities. They all have one thing in common. They want competent and compassionate medical care.

Our second site has been over eight years in planning. It has taken over three years of searching for the right architect and another four years of finding an honest and competent contractor. But at long last, finally, the moment we have all been waiting for. Miriam Medical Clinics is open to provide the compassionate, community care we have promised. The doctor is in, finally.

This new site is located in South Philadelphia, immediately adjacent to Tasker Street Missionary Baptist Church. Our new staff hires will include a Registered Nurse, Physician Assistant, and Medical Assistant. The new site is fully outfitted, newly furnished, and supplied. We have maintained our affiliations with the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine, Philadelphia University of the Sciences, Temple University, and most importantly, YOU!

We will have an official, GRAND OPENING in September of this year. In the meantime, take note, The Doctor Is In, *Finally*.
